Initial introduction ratios:

Pre-school 1:3

Reception 1:4

KS1-2 1:8

Ks 1-2 class tool kit - (based on 8 children working at a time)

8 stubby ball-pein hammers

1 claw hammer

4 draper pistol grip hand drills

4 PZ2 stubby screwdrivers

4 G-clamps

10 pairs safety glasses (teacher to also wear plus spare pair)

1 Japanese ice bear saw

1 larger pull saw – (con P)

1 Japanese nail puller

(Estimated cost of above £200) - For suppliers see equipment list handout

Consumables:

Sandpaper

Nails

Screws

Stubby 3.5mm drill bits (pack of 10)

Workbench with vice – essential – can be shared between classes. (Community Playthings and other manufacturers)

Wood and materials:

Small amount of balsa wood for first introduction lesson – then straight onto soft wood

Collect assorted offcuts of soft wood and various materials such as: cork slices, buttons, beads, fabric, string/wool/ribbon, leather offcuts, MDF wheels, mini branch sections, blind samples/fabric book samples, CDs, pipe cleaners, dowel, cotton reels, rubber bands, foam, wire, glue (PVA), nuts and bolts, hinges and catches, hooks and eye-hooks, metal bottle tops
